Greetings in the Lord.

"May God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ give you grace and peace."

By virtue of Our pastoral office, We hereby appoint you as **Pastor** of the parish of **Holy Cross, in Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada**, and We grant you all faculties, which pertain to the said office according to the Code of Canon Law, Decrees of Vatican II, Diocesan Statutes and approved custom in our Diocese.

As Pastor, you will share the care of souls, in this determined section of Our diocese.

"It is your duty to preach the word of God to all the faithful so that they, being firmly rooted in faith, hope and charity, may grow in Christ, and the Christian community may give that witness to charity which the Lord commended... You should ensure that the celebration of the Eucharistic Sacrifice is the center and culmination of the entire life of the Christian community... You should visit the homes and the schools as your pastoral function requires of you; you should exercise a paternal charity towards the poor and the sick; you should manifest a special interest in adolescents and young people; you should be to the service of all your parishioners working to the growth of spiritual life in each of your parishioners as well as in each member of the parish councils or associations, particularly with regard to apostolic activities..." (*Christus Dominus, Vatican II, October 28, 1965, No. 30*).

This appointment will be effective as of **May 1st, 2015** for a term of six (6) years renewable, in conformity with the Diocesan Legislation.

According to Canon 527 § 2, you are hereby dispensed from the observance of the Rite prescribed for the canonical possession of your parish; however, notice of your appointment will be made known to the parishioners of **Holy Cross** on the first Saturday / Sunday at the time of your arrival in the Parish.

You will make your Profession of Faith and take the Oath of Fidelity as required by Canon Law in the presence of the Chancellor or his delegate.
